Frequently Asked Questions

What is included in the ticket price?

Only the circus show is included in the ticket price. Seating is not allocated. Please be considerate of smaller guests when choosing your seat.

Are there animals?

No, this is an animal free circus.

Can I film & take photos?

Photos & filming inside the tent is not permitted. Please also keep phones on silent to ensure they do not distract the performers. Circus performers will be available for photos after each showing outside of the tent. We ask that you avoid uploading photos of other families to social media without their permission.

Can children attend alone?

Children under the age of 18 must have a responsible adult with them.

How early should I arrive?

Please collect your wristband from the check in point at least 30 minutes before your show time. Please ensure you are seated 10 minutes before the showing.

Where is my ticket?

Your tickets were emailed to you on the day you booked. Each ticket has a QR code, which we will need to scan on the day to issue your show time wristband. We recommend taking a screenshot of your tickets, to assist you with finding them at the check in point.

What can I take in with me?

For the safety of the performers and the consideration of others please do not bring pets, fidget toys, balloons, food or drink into the circus tent. Phones should be put on silent.

What else is there to do?

We have invited external stallholders, food vendors and performers to the school grounds to enhance the overall experience. These items are chargeable. We are hoping for good weather, so please feel free to bring a picnic blanket and packed lunch if you wish. As we have a licence to sell alcohol on the day, you will not be permitted to bring alcohol in your picnic. You do not have to be attending the circus to enjoy the other activities available.

Can I buy food & drink?

You are welcome to purchase food and drink from the various vendors, but please remember food & drink will not be permitted in the circus tent; so please purchase food & drink well before or after your show time.

Is this event open to the general public?

Tickets will be marketed to the school community first, you are welcome to buy tickets for family and friends. From the 9th of March any remaining tickets will be marketed to the general public. Once the tickets are sold out, there is no flexibility to add more. When they are gone, they are gone.

How many early bird tickets are available?

There are 50 tickets for each showing available at the early bird price of £8 each, once these are sold the remaining tickets are available for £10 each.

If for example you need 4 tickets, but only 2 are left at the early bird rate, you will need to purchase 2 early bird tickets and 2 standard priced tickets for the same show time.

Will parking be available?

There will be on site parking for up to 50 cars in the school car park for attendees. This will be allocated on a first come first served basis. All cars are to be removed from the car park by 5.30pm on Saturday the 4th of May. Owners are responsible for their own vehicles, parking is at your own risk. Fairfields PTFA & Fairfields Primary School & Nursery accept no liability for any theft or damage to your vehicle.

Toilets

We have hired portable toilets for this event; these include a disabled toilet and baby change facility.

The art block toilets are reserved for circus staff only.

Anything else?

Outdoor Gym equipment, Trim Trail and EYFS equipment are strictly out of bounds.
