Key Stage 1 – Year Two

The Children study two religions – *Christianity* and Islam.

In the Autumn Term the children consider:-

Ultimate Questions: -
What did Jesus teach?

Sources of Wisdom: -
Christmas - Jesus as a gift from God.
The children study Christian teaching and the Christmas story.

In the Spring Term the children encompass the question of

Prayer, Worship and reflection:-
Prayer at home -
The children consider prayer at home as well as prayer in a designated place of worship.

Symbols and Actions: -
Easter - The Resurrection:-
Investigation of Christian Passover and Easter.

In the Summer Term *Beliefs and Practices* are studied alongside *Identity and Belonging:* -
The children learn about the Muslim pilgrimage to Mecca, called Hajj.

Pupils will be supported to:-

- . Know, understand and explore the significance and impact of sacred texts, other sources of wisdom and ways of expressing meaning;
- . express ideas and insights about the nature of beliefs, values and practices and their impact upon the identity of individuals and communities;
- . recognise and explore the diversity which exists within and between different religions;
- . express with increasing discernment their personal reflections, critical responses and connections to faith and belief enquiring into philosophical, moral and ethical issues;
- . engage with questions and answers offered by religions and worldviews concerning ultimate questions and human responsibility;
- . develop the skills required to engage with others in dialogue and to cooperate in society with respect and compassion.
