MISCELLANEOUS

During the Summer Term, we plan outdoor sessions of PE so please ensure your child comes into school wearing a suitable pair of **trainers**. ENGLISH

We will also continue to build on our grammar, spelling skills and rules learnt last term, as well as developing skills in creative writing and reading comprehension. Your child will continue to bring home spellings each week. These will be given out on a Monday and tested on a Friday.

In the second half of the term, we will read the novel '**Iron Man**' by Ted Hughes.

Please ensure your child brings their reading book and reading record to school every day.

Please continue to read both the school reading book and any other texts with your child at home and record this in their record book. Any access children get to fiction and non-fiction books, especially those linked to our school topics will greatly assist their learning. All the support given at home reaps huge rewards!

MATHS

Maths is taught daily through a variety of units. These will focus mainly on expanded methods of all 4 operations, as well as measures, shape & space and data handling. We are still practising our times tables daily and using Times Tables Rockstars. We also complete an arithmetic test each week. Please encourage your child to continue to use TTRockstars. Knowing as many times tables as possible will greatly support their learning. The children are expected to know their times tables up to 12x12 and will be completing the Year 4 Multiplication Check in June.
