This week in Literacy we will continue to introduce the children to Little Wandle **Phase 2 phonic sounds**. **Our sounds for the week will be: g, o, c, k**

We will be continuing to teach the children to read and recognise their own names and would love them to practise this at home too. Encouraging and modelling correct pencil grip and letter formation is very important at this stage.

We will be learning to read, write and build words using the sounds that we have learnt. **The homework sheet will help you to support your child with this at home. Please ensure that your child is secure in the four sounds by the end of the week.**

We are working very hard on hearing and recognising initial sounds in words and you can help your child by playing games at home such as 'I Spy,' 'Alphabet Bingo' or initial sound picture snap.

As always, we will be enjoying lots of stories and learning traditional Nursery Rhymes and songs throughout the week.

Maths

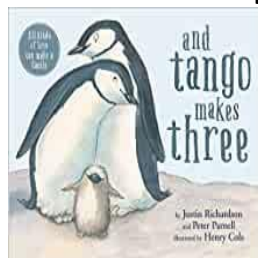
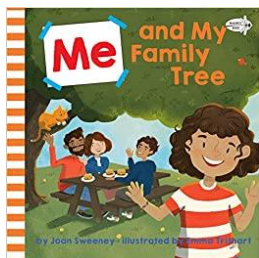
