The yellow toy sheep is to the right of the pink toy sheep.

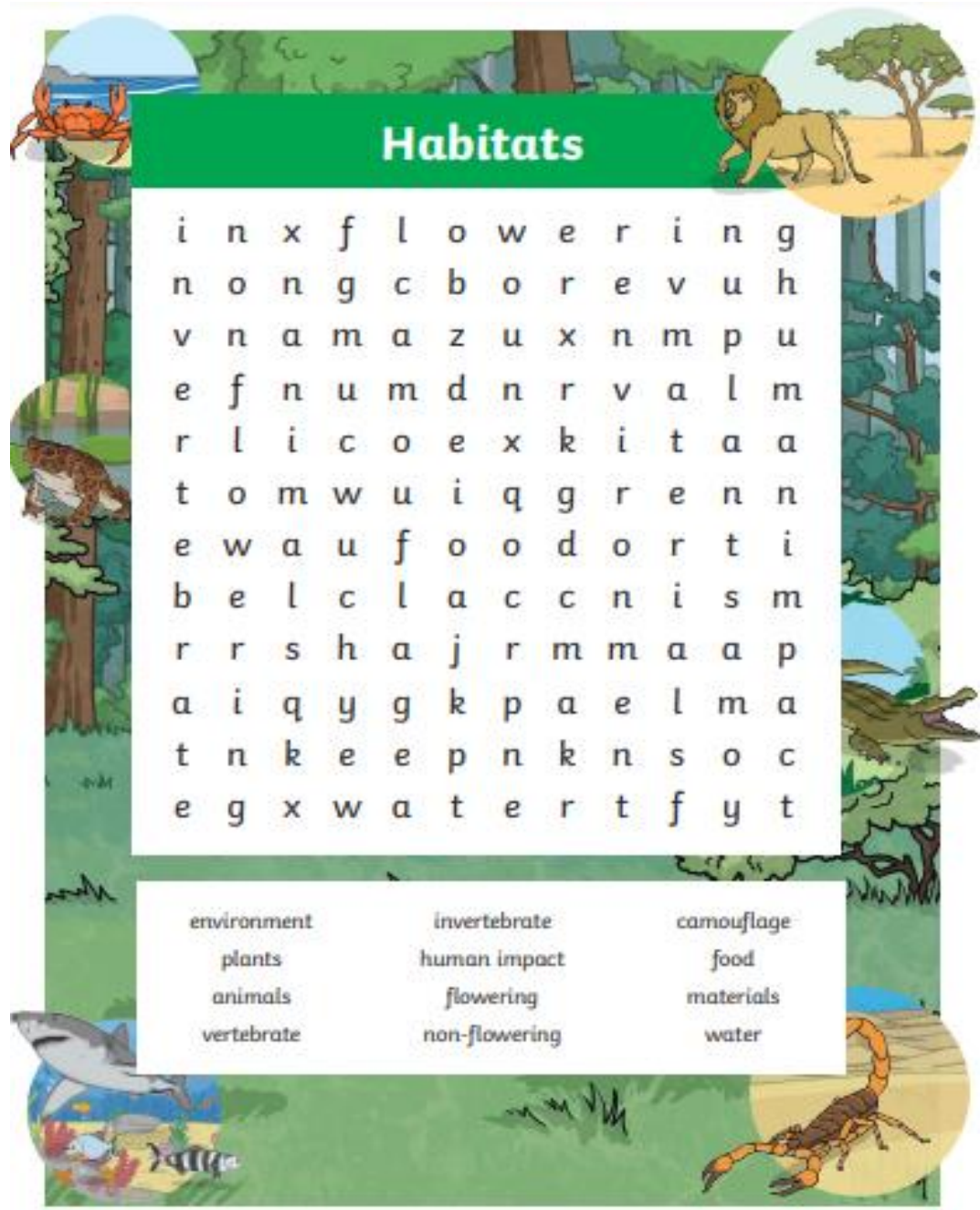


Science
