This week in English, we will continue our novel, *Letters from The Lighthouse* by Emma Carroll. We will write a recount based on the events in the text and write a character profile. In grammar, we will be looking at how prefixes are used to create antonyms.

- ✓ Look at how sentences are punctuated with full stops, commas, capital letters, question marks and exclamation marks. Discuss how they help with meaning and fluency when reading a text aloud.

This week in maths we will learn about:


- multiplying and dividing decimals;
