Maths

In maths, we will be continuing our work on fractions. We will be recognising unit and non-unit fractions and understanding the equivalence of a half and two-quarters. We will also be recognising and finding three quarters.

What can you do at home to help your child?

Food Fractions (Halves & Quarters): Cut pizza, sandwiches, or apples into two or four equal parts. Ask, "If we have 4 slices and eat 1, how many quarters are left?".

Object Sharing: Use items like grapes, toys, or crayons to find fractions of amounts. For example, take 12 items and ask to find fractions by sharing them into three equal piles.

Paper Folding & Colouring: Fold shapes into halves, quarters, or thirds, then shade the parts.
