This week in maths we will be looking at different areas of time such as:

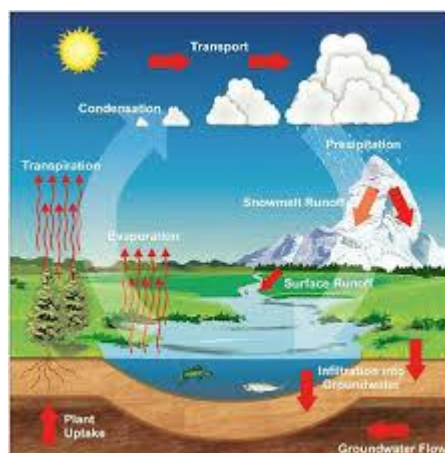
- years, months, weeks and days;
