Literacy



This week in Literacy we will continue to learn how to blend sounds for reading. Our phonic focus for this week is v, w, x and y – we pronounce x as 'cs'. We will continue to read and write very simple captions and sentences such as – 'a red hat' – 'a big bat' etc.

We will focus on oral blending working on 'cv' words (is, it, in) and 'cvc' words (cat, mat, hat etc.) Please play word games with your child.



*Subitising is when you are able to look at a group of objects and know how many there are without counting.
