Literacy

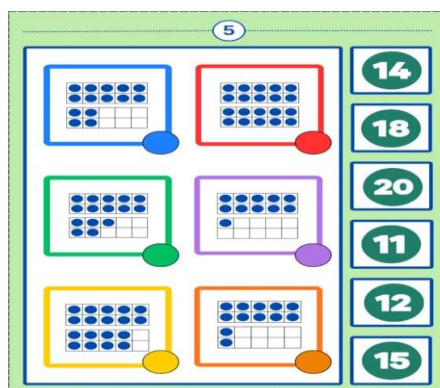
I wonder what the weather is like today?
