What can you do at home to help your child?

- ✓ Read **with** your child and **to** your child; perhaps they could read aloud to another child or adult.
- ✓ Look at a page from a reading book and identify where capital letters and full stops are.

Maths

We will be working with numbers up to 100. We will be writing numbers up to 100. We will be partitioning numbers up to 100. We will be using number lines.

What can you do at home to help your child?

- ✓ Ensure your child knows their number bonds to 10 and progress to 20.
- ✓ More confident children can practise adding multiples of 10.
- ✓ Practise adding and taking away mentally.
- ✓ Make up addition and subtraction 'stories'. - e.g. There are five birds in a tree, two fly away. How many are left? What if one flies back? How many now?
- ✓ Children should be able to have fun with maths - numbers used should relate to the ability and confidence of the child.

Geography

We will be looking at physical and human features on maps. We will focus on different types of forests and how they would feature on a map. The children will have resources to examine and they will attempt to record their own features on a simple map.
