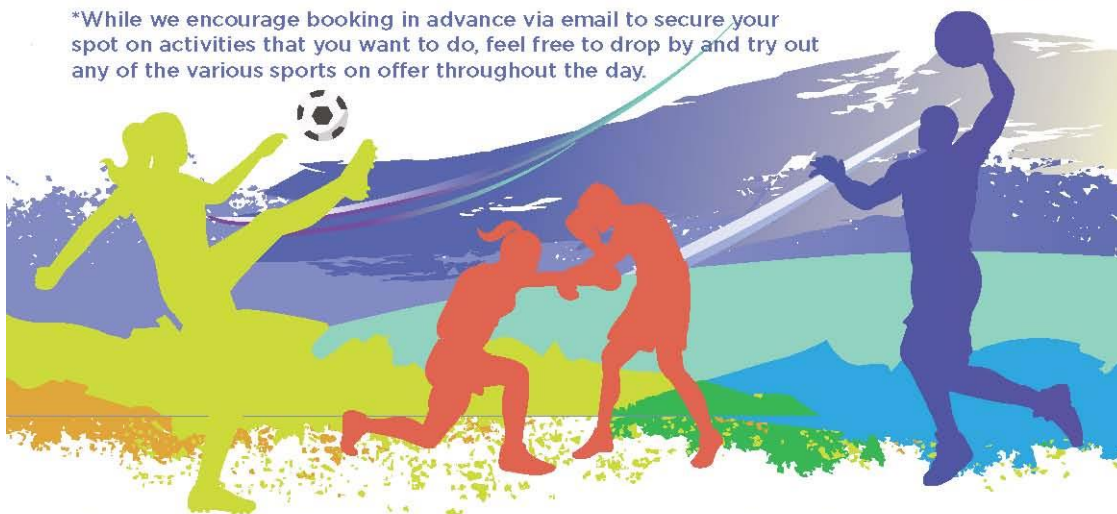

Re: Primary French Club

Goffs Academy are delighted to inform you that we will be running Primary French lessons this academic year, commencing Monday 15th September 2025. Please see below for the days and times.

Year 1 - 3.40 - 4.20pm	Year 4 - 3.40 - 4.20pm
Year 2 - 4.25 - 5.05pm	Year 5 - 4.25 - 5.05pm
Year 3 - 5.10 - 5.50pm	Year 6 - 5.10 - 5.50pm

There will be a charge of £4.50 per child per lesson to cover the costs of providing these sessions. Spaces will be offered first to parents of a child/children who previously attended the French Club, and the remainder of spaces will be then offered on a first come, first served basis.

- Wednesday Classes - £162.00 per year (36 lessons)
